Dear Sir,

Could you please grant me a year's leave without pay from 28th Aug., 1992 to 30th Sept.. 1993?

During this period I am going to take part in several oceanic research voyages—aboard American and Canadian vessels. I want to carry out a round of tests in the field of biometeorology and climatology with particular regard to the problems of winds (the subject of my doctor's thesis). Due to the interest and favourable opinions of some representatives of the American scientific circles I have received a lot of invitations.

At present I am planning to take part in three voyages. First of them will be organized by the University of Miami aboard the vessel of "Columbus Iselin" with the name connected with the anniversary of the discovery of America celebrated this year.

Another voyage (aboard the vessel called "Tully") will be prepared by the Centre of Oceanic Climatology in Canada. I would like you to know that I have been invited by that Centre to take part in other research voyages because of the great interest for my doctor's thesis from that institution and other sponsors.

In summer 1993 I am expected to take part in the voyage aboard the vessel called "Knorr", organized by the Woods

Hole Oceanographic Institution, the largest oceanographic centre in the world carrying out pioneering research in the

field I am interested in and in other fields.

I hope that I will obtain promising research results due to my co-operation with the above-mentioned institutions. I want to remind you that I have not had proper conditions for my scientific development and my achievements have been torpedoed and minimized. Depriving me of the doctor's degree three months after I was granted it (a result of scheming within the scientific staff of my faculty) seems to prove it. At present that problem in being thoroughly examined by the appropriate bodies.

I would like to add that the leave may be prolonged due to the above-mentioned interest of the American research institutions.
